UW STD PTC


The PTC is dedicated to increasing the knowledge and skills of healthcare providers in the area of sexual health.

 - Essential STD Exam Skills course
 - Microscopic Examination of Vaginal Fluids training
 - Phlebotomy for Allied Healthcare Staff
 - STD clinical consultations (via the NNPTC CCN)
 - STD self-testing posters

A comprehensive resource that addresses the diagnosis, monitoring, and management of hepatitis B virus infection.

UW PTC Regional Learning Community (RLC)
