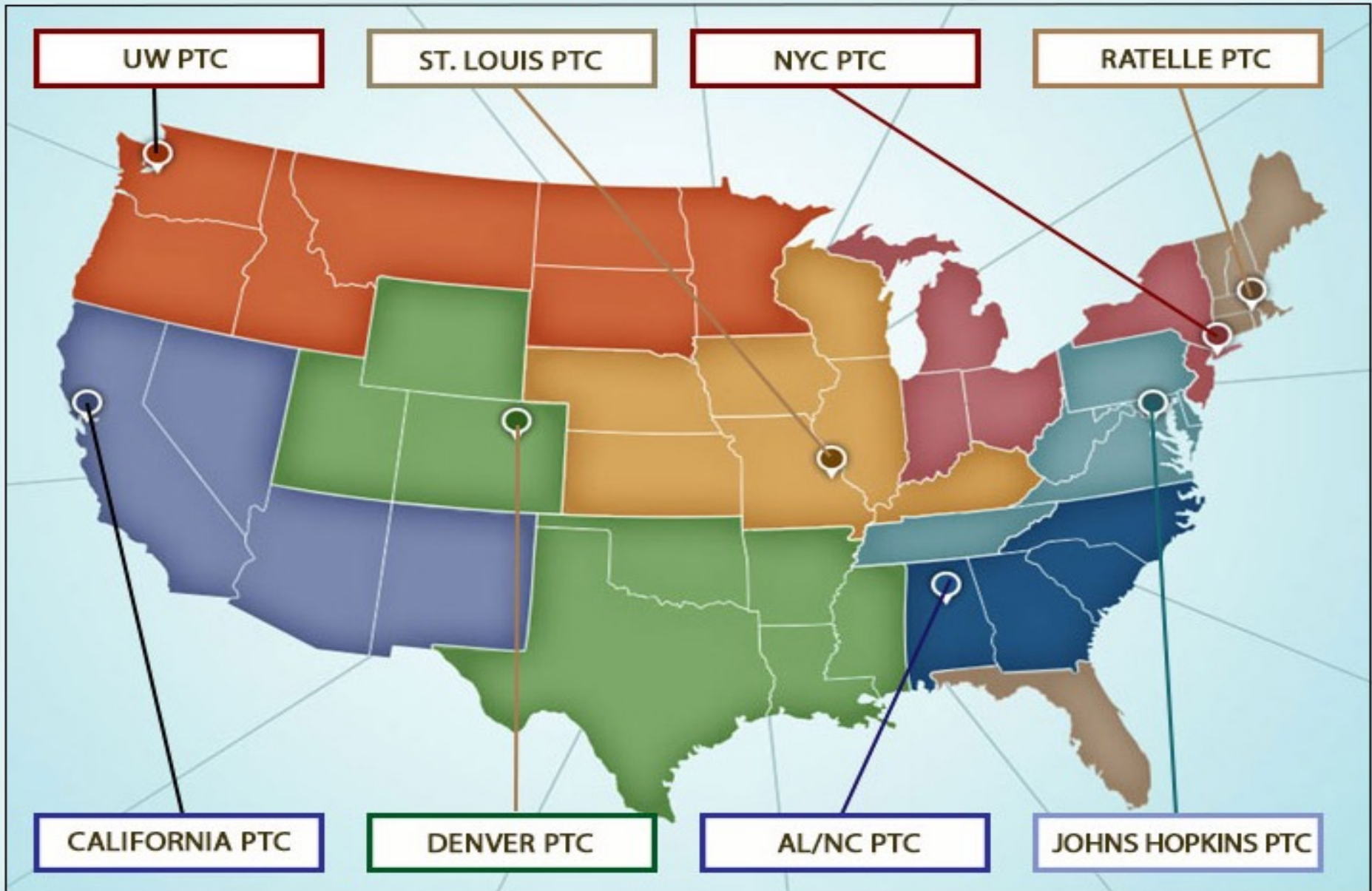
UW STD PTC

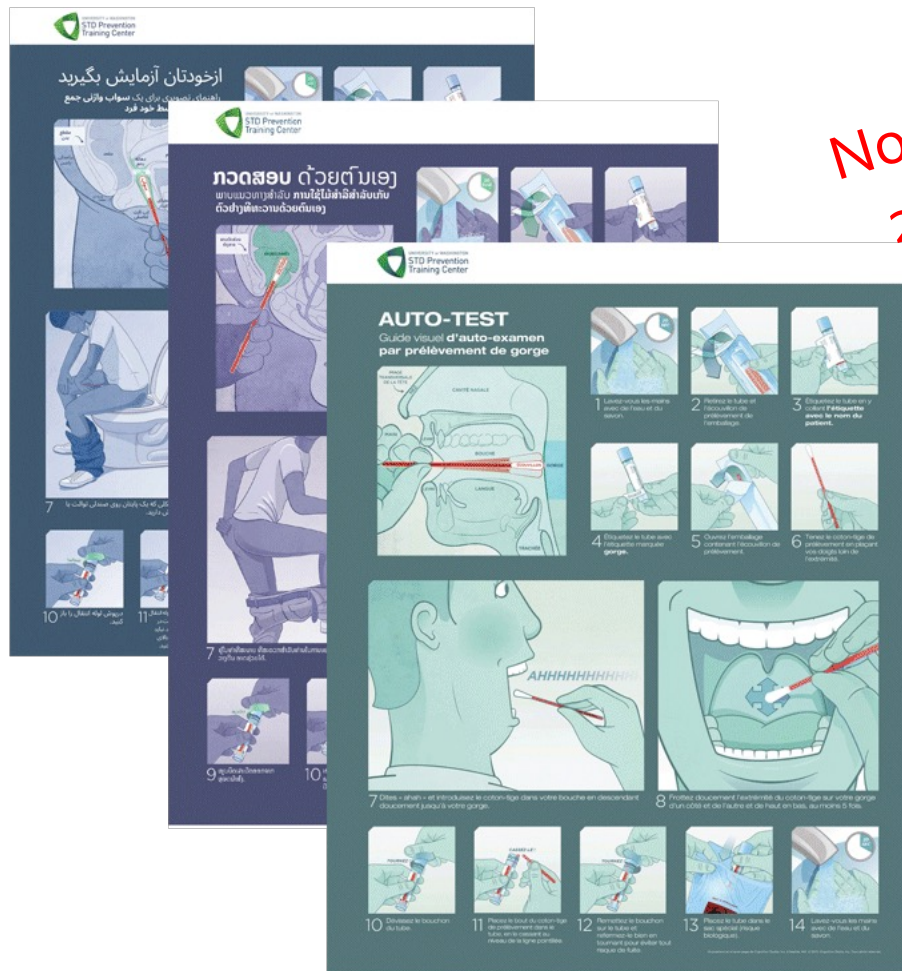
A comprehensive resource that addresses the diagnosis, monitoring, and management of hepatitis B virus infection.

UW PTC Regional Learning Community (RLC)

- Quarterly, 1-hour Zoom sessions
